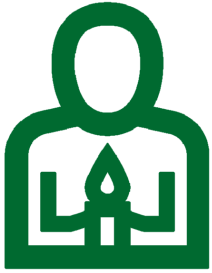


Wolvesey Tea: Today 3pm - 5pm

Remember to bring (nut-free) **grub, mug and rug** (or chair) this afternoon. Parking is very limited, so please park in streets further away.

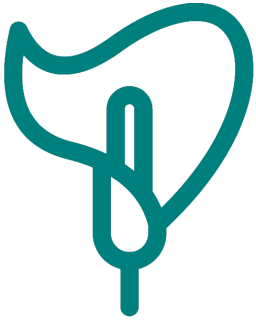
No evening service but Download is on at the earlier time of 6pm-7.30pm.

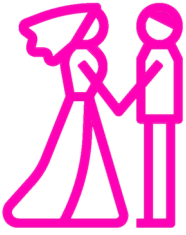


We urgently require helpers for the Children, Youth and Families groups which serve over 100 children
